Heads Up Hold'em

HOW TO PLAY

WPT Heads Up Hold 'Em features head-up play against the dealer and has several betting options. This game gives you several advantages:

- The earlier you bet, the more you can bet
- You don't have to fold until you see all the community cards
- The Trips Plus Bonus wager pays if your best 5-card hand is a Three of a Kind or better
- The Pocket Bonus wager pays if your two "pocket" cards are a pair or an "Ace-Face"
- You can win the Bad Beat Bonus if you have a Straight or higher and lose to the dealer

GETTING STARTED

Place equal bets in the Ante and Odds betting circles. You may also make optional bets on the Trips Plus Bonus and Pocket Bonus wagers. You will then receive two cards.

BET BIG... OR SMALL... OR NOT AT ALL

When you get your two hole cards, you can either check or bet 3x your Ante on the Raise Wager. The dealer then reveals the three-card flop. If you haven't already made a Raise Wager, you have a choice: check or bet 2x your Ante on the Raise Wager. The dealer then reveals the final two community cards. If you haven't already made a Raise Wager, you have a choice: bet 1x your Ante on the Raise Wager or fold.

WINNING AND LOSING

The dealer then reveals his/her two hole cards and announces his/her hand

- If your hand beats the dealer's, your Ante and Raise Wagers win even money
- If the dealer's hand beats yours, your Ante, Raise, and Odds bets lose
- If you win with a Straight or better your Odds bet will win
- If you win with less than a Straight you Odds bet will push
- If you lose with a Straight or better you will win the Bad Beat Bonus for your Odds bet
- If you tie the dealer the Ante, Odds, and Raise Wagers are a push

DEALER QUALIFYING

The dealer needs a pair to qualify. When the dealer doesn't qualify, he/she returns your Ante Wager. All other bets have action.
